How to apply for accommodation via KEA:	All incoming exchange students will receive one (!) offer of accommodation directly from KEA. Alternatively, they may organize this via a 3 rd part on their own. 1-2 month(s) prior to arrival they will receive the offer of accommodation, tenancy agreement and invoice for the deposit and

	<p>rent with instructions. <u>Note that students accepting the housing offer are required to pay the full amount (deposit + rent for the whole period of study in Copenhagen) upfront by a deadline approximately 1 month prior to their arrival.</u></p> <p>We highly recommend that incoming exchange students accept the housing offer from KEA, since the housing market is difficult and expensive in Copenhagen and it can be very complicated to find housing on your own.</p>
